



Sablet

Le Fournas

Origin : Plots of vines planted on the Sablet commune, a “Côtes-du-Rhône Villages”. The place name “Le Fournas” refers to a south facing hillside in the Trignon Valley.

Grape varieties : Bourboulenc 35%, Viognier 30%, Grenache 15%, Clairette 15%, Roussanne 5%.

Production process : White due to immediate pressing. Bottling without any malo-lactic fermentation.

Particularity : A very fresh white wine from the South. Its low pH level gives it a brilliant colour and creates a balance with the heaviness of the Viogniers from the South.

Land : Soft sandy calcareous soil (hence the origin of the village’s name “Sablet”).
